- The Foresight Policy Accelerator—A legislative support team that helps Congress and federal agencies integrate foresight principles into long-term policy frameworks, ensuring strategic agility.
- The Civic Foresight Engagement Hub—Bridging government foresight with citizen-driven innovation, this division hosts open-source foresight competitions, citizens' assemblies, future preparedness summits, and partnerships with universities, think tanks, social sector organizations, and businesses.
